

Early Voting Information & Application

An early voting ballot application for the November 5, 2024 General Election is below. To request an early voting ballot, complete the form, sign, and return it to the Adams County Clerk by mail, *email, fax or hand delivery.

If you have an address change within Adams County, you may also use this form to update your address. Ballots CANNOT be forwarded, so provide a valid residential or mailing address.

New this year: You MUST provide your Nebraska driver's license or state ID number to comply with Nebraska's Voter ID law, OR you may provide a copy of another valid government-issued ID (passport, military ID, in-state college ID etc.) or a reasonable impediment certification (call the office or see the website voterid.nebraska.gov for details)

Important Early Voting Application Dates:

Deadline to return an early voting application: **By mail, fax or email** – 6:00 pm Friday, October 25, 2024
In person – 5:00 pm Monday, November 4, 2024

Ballots will be mailed starting on September 30, 2024. If your ballot application is received after September 30, 2024, please allow 3 to 5 business days for the ballot to be processed and mailed.

* **Emailing an early vote application:** This form must contain an original signature, this requires the form be printed, and signed. The form can then be scanned and sent back via email or you may take a picture of the signed form and email it to our office. Electronic signatures are not accepted.
