Establish and Conduct Permitted Lottery

Shall Adams County, Nebraska establish and conduct a lottery as permitted under the Nebraska County and City Lottery Act, which lottery would be conducted in certain designated areas of Adams County, for the purpose of community betterment as defined in such act?
