DRIVER WAS LATER ISSUED A CITATION FOR THE OFFENSE.

VEHICLE #1 WAS TRAVELLING EASTBOUND ON 12TH ST. APPROXIMATELY .25 MILE WEST OF ROSELAND AVE. VEHICLE #1 LEFT THE ROADWAY TO THE RIGHT AND COLLIDED WITH THE SOUTH DITCH, CAUSING DISABLING DAMAGE TO VEHICLE #1. VEHICLE #1 HAD BEEN PULLED OUT OF THE DITCH BY A BYSTANDER BEFORE DEPUTIES HAD ARRIVED ON SCENE. VEHICLE #1 WAS PARKED NORTH OF 12TH ST. ON ROSELAND AVE. UPON DEPUTY ARRIVAL. DRIVER #1 SHOWED SIGNS OF IMPAIRMENT AND ADMITTED TO CONSUMING ALCOHOL PRIOR TO THE ACCIDENT. DRIVER #1 STATED SHE HAD BEEN EASTBOUND ON 12TH STREET DRIVING TOWARDS HASTINGS PRIOR TO THE ACCIDENT. DRIVER #1 ALSO STATED SHE WAS TRAVELING APPROXIMATELY 70 MPH PRIOR TO THE ACCIDENT WHEN SHE HIT A PATCH OF GRAVEL, CAUSING HER TO LOSE CONTROL. NO GRAVEL WAS LOCATED ON 12TH STREET BEFORE THE LOCATION WHERE VEHICLE #1 LEFT THE ROADWAY. DRIVER #1 WAS ARRESTED FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL.

THE DRIVER OF VEHICLE #1 WAS A FIRST RESPONDER IN HIS PRIVATE VEHICLE WHO WAS CALLED TO CRYSTAL LAKE RECREATION AREA FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY. THIS RECREATION AREA IS OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF AYR AND THEREFORE IS PUBLIC PROPERTY. WHILE AT THIS LOCATION FOR THE MEDICAL EMERGENCY, THE DRIVER OF VEHICLE #1 WAS STOPPED IN THE SOUTHBOUND LANE OF THE ROADWAY UNTIL HE ULTIMATELY WENT TO MOVE HIS VEHICLE OFF OF THE ROADWAY AND ONTO THE GRASSY SHOULDER. DRIVER OF VEHICLE #1 DID NOT SEE A PARKED VEHICLE #2 ON THE GRASSY SHOULDER AND AS HE PROCEEDED EAST FROM THE GRAVEL ROADWAY AND ONTO THE GRASSY SHOULDER, HE SAME DIRECTION SIDESWIPE THE PARKED VEHICLE.
