Week Summary:

August 10, 2026

UNIT 1/VEHICLE 1 WAS WESTBOUND ON 42ND ST. UNIT 2/VEHICLE 2 WAS NORTHBOUND ON HIGHLAND RD. UNIT 1 FAILED TO YIELD AT THE YIELD SIGN AND COLLIDED WITH UNIT 2'S PASSENGER SIDE IN THE INTERSECTION OF 42ND ST AND HIGHLAND RD. WHEN UNIT 1 COLLIDED WITH UNIT 2, UNIT 2 ROLLED A 1/4 TURN, COMING TO A REST ON THE DRIVER'S SIDE OF THE VEHICLE. UNIT 2 SPUN 180 DEGREES, COMING TO A REST IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION FACING EAST. THE DRIVER OF UNIT 1 WAS ISSUED A CITATION FOR VIOLATION OF A YIELD SIGN. THE DRIVER OF UNIT 2 WAS ISSUED A CITATION FOR DRIVING UNDER REVOCATION.

THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE LOST CONTROL AND SLID OFF THE ROADWAY TO THEIR RIGHT, THEN COLLIDED WITH THE DITCH, NOSE DOWN IN THE DITCH. WHILE STILL ON SCENE, WHEN THE TOW TRUCK WAS PULLING THE VEHICLE OUT OF THE DITCH, THE HASTINGS STREET DEPARTMENT CLOSED THE ROAD DOWN WITH BARRICADES DUE TO THE ROAD CONDITIONS.
