DRIVER OF V-1 STATED SHE WAS NORTHBOUND ON HIGHWAY 281 IN LEFT LANE. DRIVER OF V-1 STATED THAT V-2 WAS IN THE RIGHT LANE AND STARTED TO MERGE INTO HER LANE AS IT WAS PASSING HER. DRIVER OF V-1 STATED THAT V-2 STRUCK THE PASSENGER SIDE OF HER VEHICLE, CAUSING BOTH VEHICLES TO GO INTO THE MEDIAN. DRIVER OF V-1 STATED THAT V-2 DID NOT STOP, RE-ENTERED THE HIGHWAY AND CONTINUED NORTHBOUND. DRIVER OF V-1 DESCRIBED V-2 AS POSSIBLY A JEEP OR BRONCO TYPE OF VEHICLE. NO OTHER DESCRIPTION GIVEN. WITNESS WAS SEVERAL CAR LENGTHS BEHIND V-1 AND V-2 AND CONFIRMED THE EVENTS THAT THE DRIVER OF V-1 DESCRIBED. WITNESS STATED THAT HE CAUGHT THE INCIDENT ON DASH CAM AND WOULD SEND IT VIA EMAIL TO THIS DEPUTY ONCE HE RETRIEVES IT FROM SD CARD. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. V-1 HAD SIGNIFICANT FRONT END AND PASSENGER SIDE COSMETIC DAMAGE TO VEHICLE. V-1 WAS ABLE TO DRIVE AWAY FROM THE SCENE. THIS OCCURRED IN A SEVERAL MILE STRETCH OF NORTHBOUND US HWY 281 IN WHICH WAS RECENTLY ARMOR COATED AND ONLY HAS SPARSELY PLACED REFLECTORS TO MARK CENTERLINE, LANE LINE, AND EDGE LINE AS IT HAS NOT BEEN REPAINTED.
